Our show is prerecorded so if there is anything at all you would like to go back and say differently, or you want us to take out entirely we will do our best to accommodate you.

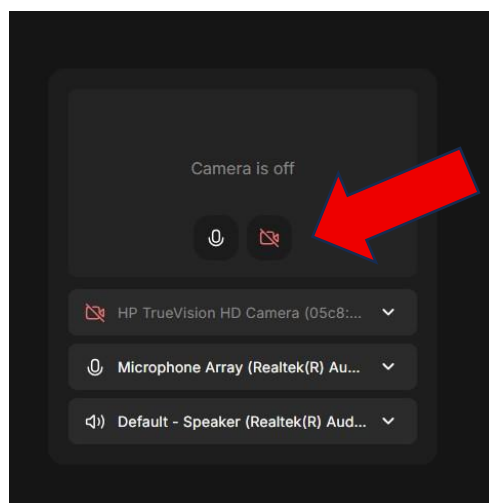
Tech: We have recently changed studio platforms and are no longer utilizing MS Teams. This decision was made after multiple login failures which have greatly affected our ability to function. We are currently working with the Riverside FM ap, which is available for both mobile or online.

For PC: Using your preferred web browser navigate to <https://riverside.fm/login> and set up one of their free accounts. Use of a VPN and certain content blocking software will interfere with device to server communication and can create technical difficulties while in the session. If you use any of these items on your PC, we recommend using the Mobile application instead. More information on this issue can be found at:

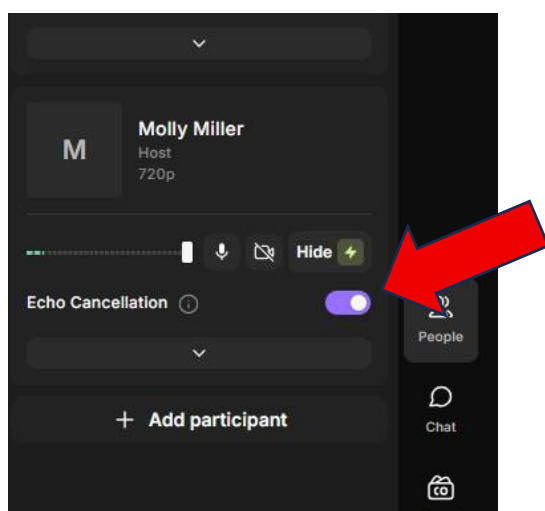

For Mobile: Open your ap store of choice and search for riverside.fm and install.

Once you have the ap installed on your preferred communication device, check to make certain your microphone is turned up and of adequate quality so our audience can hear and understand you. We are currently broadcasting audio only, so web cam or a camera are not required. You will have to allow access to microphones and cameras, but can disable the camera from inside the suite.



When you join the studio, find your audio controls on the right-hand side of the screen. Check to make certain your “Echo Cancellation” bar is turned on. This needs to be taken care of right away as it cannot be changed after recording has started.



15 minutes prior recording time. Molly will place the link to the session in the preshow DM which you share with her and Danielle. If this is inconvenient in any way, please let Molly know. She will be happy to email it instead.

If the link fails to work, please reach out through Twitter DM, or email.

Introductions: Our recording space is incredibly casual, but there will be some times where we ask for official introductions. You may absolutely use your Twitter handle for this or some variant thereof so that we have a name to call you by. Once that is settled, tell us a little about yourself. This is the perfect opportunity to plug any projects you may be working on.

Recording and Interview: Sometime during recording either Danielle or Molly will ask you “What did you do this week?” Tell us about your week and the things you accomplished. Expect the conversation to rabbit hole. You may also turn the tables and ask the same of Danielle and Molly. Jump in and participate in the conversation as much as possible. Please excuse our hosts for their blue language and raw senses of humor.

Also, as we are using these Guest and Super Episodes to create “Best of” and “Reserve” reels for our end of season Thanksgiving and Christmas episodes expect out of the blue questions such as “What is your favorite Christmas memory?” or “What was the worst Thanksgiving side dish you’ve ever eaten?” Feel free to tell that story as long and as deeply woven as you please.

B-Roll: Our extra cuts at the intro and outro of the show is what makes WDYDTWPodcast so unique. We will announce when the recording is started, but it will roll for the entirety of the meeting. Not all of what we record ends up in the finished product, but even the loose ends can be used for intro and outro takes.

We hope this guide helps you prepare you for your interview. We are very excited to have you as our guest and are looking forward to recording with you.
